1 Frenship: The Tigers (4-2) win again against Clovis, 27-21. Frenship remains in the top spot because it sealed a win after letting Clovis creep back from a three-touchdown deficit.

2 Cooper: A huge second half gave the Pirates (4-2) a 46-15 win over Caprock.

3 Coronado: The Mustangs (3-3) follow up an upset over Odessa Permian with a victory over Hobbs behind five touchdowns from quarterback J.T. Morris.

4 Monterey: A 55-41 loss to Palo Duro sets the Plainsmen (3-3) back one spot on this list. They have the opportunity to make a huge statement Friday against Frenship.

5 Shallowater: Snyder dealt the Mustangs (4-1) their first loss of the year, but coach Kyle Maxfield's team remains in this spot for taking a Class 4A team from an outstanding district into overtime.

6 Estacado: The Matadors (4-2) capitalized on three turnovers in a 33-25 win over San Angelo Lake View.

7 Plainview: Making their debut on this list, the Bulldogs (3-3) abused Hereford and could climb the list even more with a strong showing against District 4-5A foe Abilene Cooper next week.

8 Seagraves: The Eagles (6-0) beat Trinity Christian 66-14 and host Sundown Friday.

9 Levelland: A two-point conversion in the fourth quarter was the difference in Levelland's (2-4) 28-27 loss to Bushland.

10 Idalou: The Wildcats (3-2) will have had two weeks to stew over their loss to Shallowater.
