## Week 7

**1 [Frenship](#):** After [Monterey](#)'s first drive against the Tigers (5-2), it looked like the Plainsmen were going to be able to trade scores with [Frenship](#). It didn't work out that way and [Frenship](#) picked up a convincing 63-28 win. Quarterback Parker Bingham threw sparingly, but was successful. It's an important wrinkle to the [Frenship](#) offense since Grant Sandercox (six touchdowns in the game) and Ronald Awatt are known commodities.

**2 [Cooper](#):** The Pirates (5-2) have made everyone forget that they were once 1-2 earlier this season. Lubbock High is next up for [Cooper](#), but the real test in this district will come against Plainview on Oct. 24.

**3 [Coronado](#):** The Mustangs (3-4) lost to Amarillo High, 56-10. It's not a complete surprise that Coronado's run defense struggled — it showed that deficiency earlier in the season — but if the offense can't generate more than a Conner Dean field goal and a single Brandon Sherlin touchdown reception, it will struggle for the rest of district play.

**4 [Monterey](#):** Wayne Hutchinson's team (3-4) never quit against [Frenship](#). Vincent Johnson won't run roughshod over every team [Monterey](#) plays because he is so highly recognized.

**5 [Shallowater](#):** The Mustangs (6-1) beat Kermit 55-0. After the ability they showed in wins against [Estacado](#) and Idalou, they won't be challenged against until Brownfield on Oct. 31.

**6 [Estacado](#):** The Matadors (5-2) downed Borger 21-7 with a healthy Kenaris Jackson back. Jackson caught four passes for 64 yards and Jaleen Tennison ran for two scores.

**7 [Plainview](#):** After beating Hereford two weeks ago, the Bulldogs (3-3) had a bye and face Abilene [Cooper](#) Friday. They could challenge [Cooper](#) in [District 4-5A](#).

**8 [Seagraves](#):** The Eagles (7-0) topped Sundown 54-6. A loss is unlikely.

**9 [Idalou](#):** The Wildcats (4-2) rebounded from a Shallowater loss two weeks ago to drub Amarillo Highland Park 52-7.

**10 [Brownfield](#):** The Cubs (3-3) make their debut on this list after a 42-14 win over Denver City. That's a huge result for Bryan Welps' team.

### Off the list:

■ **[Levelland](#):** The Lobos (2-5) are bumped off this list after losing to Seminole.

**[Seminole](#):** Kent Jackson's team (3-4) had an impressive win over Levelland, but the severity of early season losses (31-6 to Idalou and 38-7 to Littlefield) hurt.

**On the bubble:** Abernathy, Crosbyton, Muleshoe, Denver City, Roosevelt, Post.
