Each week, Lone Star Varsity will compile a list of the top-performing area football players. This edition of the Super Team is composed of performances from the second round of the playoffs.

QB: Jaleen Tennison, Sr., Estacado: Tennison finished 21 of 39 passing for 355 yards and five combined touchdowns. Tennison also ran for 125 yards in the 69-60 loss to Stephenville.

UTIL: Jake Johnson, Jr., Shallowater: Johnson ran for three touchdowns against Boyd.

UTIL: Brandt Schilling, Jr., Idalou: Schilling caught two passes for 55 yards, including a touchdown reception from Zack Kirkpatrick in the Wildcats 35-14 loss to Sonora.

RB: Cory Kyle, Jr., Seagraves: In a blowout win over Gruver, Kyle ran for four touchdowns and 261 yards.

RB: Nathan Childers, Sr., Crosbyton: In a 62-34 win over Sunray, Childers ran for 280 yards and five rushing touchdowns. He also added a 55-yard touchdown reception from Tanner Clark in the second quarter.

RB: Cooper Ogle, Jr., Shallowater: Ogle rushed for 135 yards and four touchdowns in a 49-35 win over Boyd.

WR: Dorian Deary, Sr., Estacado: Deary caught two touchdowns and totaled 131 receiving yards against Stephenville.

WR: Jared Mannon, Sr., Frenship: Mannon reeled in two touchdown passes in Frenship's loss to Abilene High.

WR: Cassaus Cunningham, Sr., Abernathy: Cunningham caught two touchdown in Abernathy's 56-21 win over Hawley.

WR: Trenton Jones, Sr., Levelland: In the Lobos 75-21 loss to Abilene Wylie, Jones caught six passes for 122 yards and a touchdown.

Offensive line: Denver City: Despite a 27-26 loss, the Mustangs were able to keep pace with Brock. It had a chance to tie the game after a late touchdown before it unsuccessfully attempted a two-point conversion. Saul Gutierrez, Daniel Garcia and Cole McLeroy were all successful rushing the ball.
