LSV SUPER TEAMS — SECOND TEAM

Offense

QB: Kolton Ehlers, Sr., Cooper: Ehlers passed for 1,939 yards and 17 touchdowns with a 70 percent completion rate. He also rushed for 817 yards and 12 scores.

RB: Barry Johnson, Sr., Sudan: Johnson carried for 2,114 yards and 29 touchdowns.

RB: Warren Flye, Sr., <u>Plainview</u>: Flye had 2,021 rushing yards and 449 receiving yards for 24 combined touchdowns.

UTIL: Jaleen Tennison, Sr., Estacado: The center of the Matadors pistol offense, Tennison passed for 1,216 yards and nine touchdowns while rushing for 1,254 yards and 22 scores.

TE: Preston Scaff, Sr., Shallowater: An increasingly important target for the Mustangs in the postseason, Scaff caught nine touchdowns and had 552 receiving yards.

OL: Moises Garcia, Sr., <u>Plainview</u>: Garcia graded 79 percent with 10.5 knockdowns per game. The Bulldogs offense had 4,665 yards in the regular season.

OL: James Christophe, Sr., Estacado: The two-year starter graded at 98 percent and had 31 pancakes.

OL: Sam Orth, Sr., Cooper: Orth was an important piece of a very varied Cooper offense that didn't just rely on the same few playmakers.

OL: Dustin Smith, Sr., Muleshoe: Smith graded at 90 percent with 18 pancakes and allowed one sack.

OL: Anthony Ontiveros, Sr., <u>Seagraves</u>: Ontiveros, who played in the <u>post</u>season several weeks removed from a broken collar bone, graded at 97 percent for an offense that averaged 47 points per game.

WR; Cassaus Cunningham, Sr., <u>Abernathy</u>: The 5-foot-9, 155-pound Cunningham had 16 combined touchdowns and nearly 1,000 total yards.

WR; Keagan Gonzales, Sr., <u>Muleshoe</u>: Gonzales spent three games at quarterback while Danny Campos was injured and passed for 475 yards and seven touchdowns while rushing for 540 yards and catching six touchdowns.

Special teams

K: Blake Meil, Sr., New Deal: Meil was 14 of 16 on field goal attempts and hit all three kicks he tried from 40-49 yards. Meil was 35 of 41 on extra point attempts and also had six interceptions as a cornerback.

P: Paxstyn Oldfield, Sr., Plainview: Limited to seven games because of injury, Oldfield averaged 41.2 yards per punt with a long of 69 yards.

Defense

DL: Kirby Vinson, Jr., Cooper: Vinson finished with 72 tackles and six sacks.

DL: Brant Addison, Sr., Seminole: The Indians nose guard had 89 tackles six sacks, four forced fumbles, one fumble recovery and one safety.

DL: Cole Fontenot, Sr., <u>Frenship</u>: The Tigers nose guard, who was injured late in the season, had 60 tackles, six sacks, three forced fumbles and two fumble recoveries.

LB: Hayden Harrison, Jr., Frenship: Harrison had 121 tackles and two interceptions.

LB: Trenton Jones, Sr., Plainview: Jones had 111.5 tackes, four tackles and loss and two quarterback hurries.

LB: Brian Hernandez, Sr., Snyder: Hernandez had 124 tackles, 4 sacks, nine tackles for loss and two fumbles caused.

LB: Isiah Cortez, Sr., <u>Levelland</u>: Cortez finished with 116 tackles, 10 tackles for loss, one sack, four pass breakups and an interception.

DB: Sabraun Adams, Sr., <u>Seminole</u>: After missing the first three games of the season due to injury, Adams had 48 tackles, nine pass breakups, one interception, two tackles for loss.

DB: Quenion Hines, Sr., Plainview: Hines was named to the <u>District 4-5A</u> First Team.

DB: Carl Willard, Sr., Estacado: Willard had 75 tackles, one fumble recovery and one blocked field goal.

DB: Tycer Farmer, Sr., Cooper: Farmer had 86 tackles and four interceptions.

THIRD TEAM

Offense

QB: Garrett Royal, Sr., <u>Abernathy</u>: Known for an ability to create in the space around the edges, Royal passed for 1,246 yards and 18 touchdowns and rushed for 1,120 yards and 14 scores.

RB: Cooper Ogle, Jr., Shallowater: Ogle finished with 24 touchdowns and 1,614 yards in his first season with a full-time work load.

RB: Da'madrick Moore, Sr., Littlefield: Moore carried 214 times for 1,652 yards and 21 touchdowns.

UTIL: Brandt Schilling, Sr., Idalou: Schilling had 1,833 all-purpose yards and 21 combined touchdowns.

TE: Zach Stepp, Jr., Coronado: Stepp will have an increased role in the Mustangs pass-heavy offense moving forward.

OL: Joseph Villarreal, Sr., Roosevelt: Villarreal graded 91 percent with 38 knockdowns and zero sacks.

OL: Jaybren Rodriguez, Jr., Post: Rodriguez graded at 88 percent for the year with 40 pancakes.

OL: Dakota Oliver, So., <u>Brownfield</u>: The two-year varsity player graded out at 92 percent with 32 pancakes and has not allowed a sack.

OL: Kyle Rickman, Sr., Seminole: Rickman had 113 knockdowns and 26 pancakes.

OL: Israel Vasquez, Jr., Denver City: Vasquez was part of a unit that made plenty of room for Daniel Garcia, Saul Gutierrez and Cole McLeroy to run.

WR; Jordan Demps, Sr., <u>Brownfield</u>: Demps was a special teams threat and finished with 1,405 all-purpose yards and eight touchdowns.

WR; Devante Greathouse, Jr., <u>Lubbock</u> High: Greathouse had 787 receiving yards and nine touchdowns.

K: Aron Lopez, Jr., Post: Kicker: Lopez was 26 of 28 on extra point attempts with 14 touchbacks. He also hit 7 of 10 field goal attempts with a long of 47 yards.

P: AJ Garza, Sr., Lubbock High: Garza averaged 43 yards per punt.

Defense

DL: Robby Pinon, Jr., Seagraves: On an extremely stingy Eagles defense, Pinon had 76 tackles, five sacks 12 quarterback pressures, eight forced fumbles and one defensive touchdown.

DL: Ryan Soliz, Sr., Abernathy: Soliz had 87 tackles, seven sacks, two forced fumbles and 19 tackles for loss.

DL: A.J. Reed, So. Post: Reed had 33 tackles, nine sacks, 12 tackles for loss, one blocked field goal and 14 quarterback pressures.

LB: Kaeden Taylor, Sr., Morton: Taylor had 112 solo tackles, four forced fumbles, three sacks, three pass breakups.

LB: Bryan Smith, Sr., Sundown: Smith had 143 tackles, four sacks, 13 tackles for loss, three caused fumbles and four fumble recoveries.

LB: Drew Berry, Jr., <u>Sundown</u>: Berry finished with 108 tackles, three tackles for loss, one sack, one caused fumble, one interception and eight quarterback knockdowns.

LB: Alejo Rodriguez, Sr., <u>Post</u>: Rodriguez had 124 tackles, seven tackles, one interception, three quarterback pressures and one fumble recovery.

DB: Ian Wilks, Sr., Roosevelt: Wilks had 55 tackles, four tackles for a loss, four interceptions and three fumble recoveries.

DB: Tony Vasquez, Jr., Muleshoe: Vasquez had 48 tackles, four interceptions, one forced fumble and 14 pass breakups.

DB: Jeffrey McCutcheon, Sr., Coronado: McCutcheon was a bright spot on a Mustangs defense that struggled this season.
